Accessing Nexus:

1. Enter the University of Winnipeg homepage at www.uwinnipeg.ca
2. Under the heading "Who Are You?" on the homepage, click on "Student"
3. Click on the link entitled "Nexus" under the heading "Online Tools"
4. Select "Log on to myNexus".
5. Enter your User Name and password.
6. The Nexus session for this course should now be accessible.

Claiming a User ID
