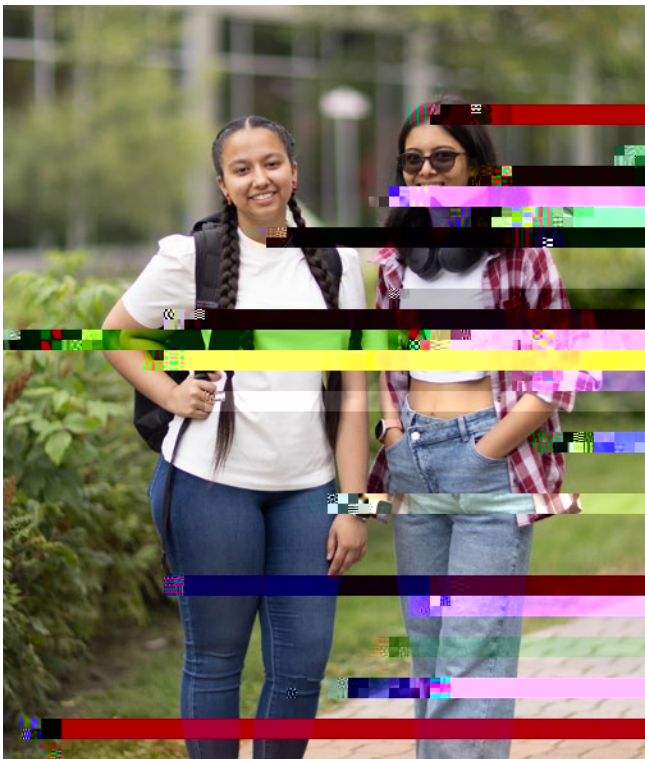

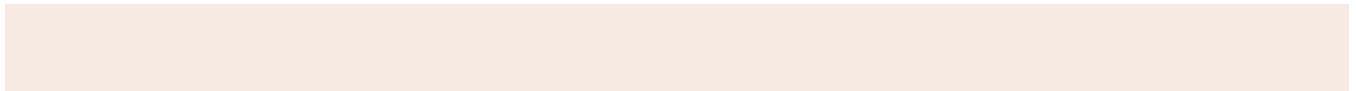

Special Note regarding Fall Reading Week (Oct. 15 - 18, 2024)

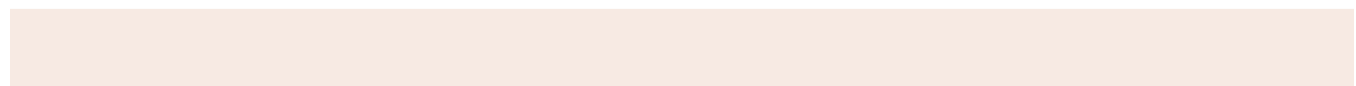
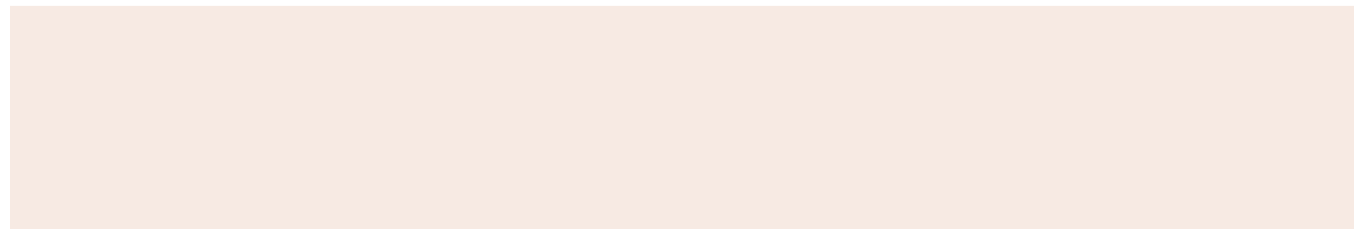
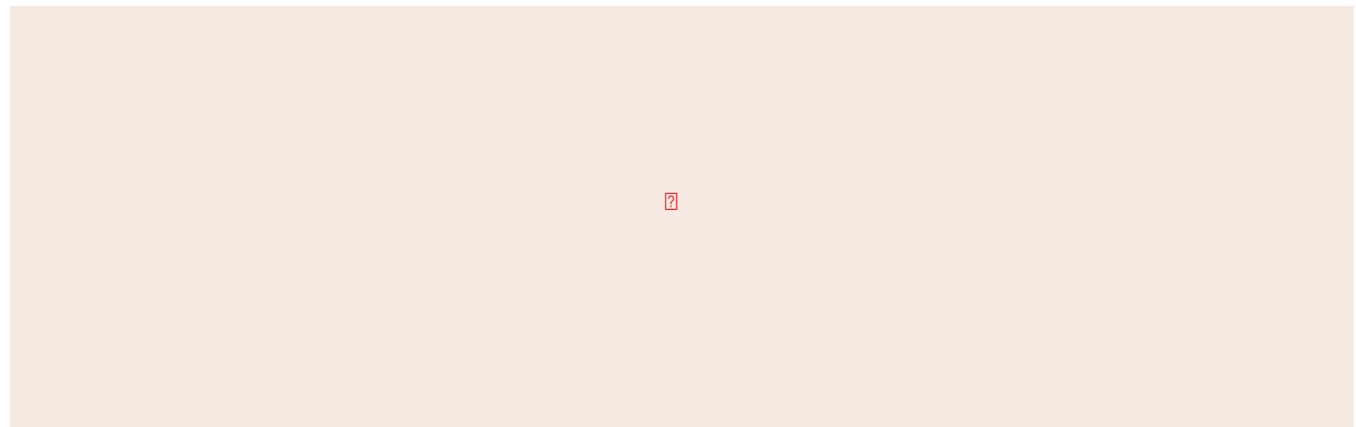
