Will my transfer credits cover all of my program and degree requirements?

No. Any transfer credits received, together with credits subsequently taken at UWinnipeg, must together meet the general and specific requirements of the Faculty and Department of your degree program. Students must fulfill all the program and residence requirements specified for the degree and major being sought.

Will all of my eligible courses be transferred in?

I am transferring from a Bible College in Canada or the USA. What conditions apply to me?

Applicants who have attended a bible college, that is a Member Institution or has Candidate Status with the *Association for Biblical Higher Education* (ABHE), may be eligible for transfer credit. Students must have satisfactorily completed a minimum of one year of study (30 credit hours or equivalent) with a cumulative grade point average of 2.50 (C+) or higher to be eligible for consideration. No credit will be granted for courses of a church/professional or clearly doctrinaire nature. Students will receive a grade of S (Standing) for each course transferred. The specific grade earned does not transfer.

I am transferring from a non-accredited (not a member of Universities Canada) university or college (includes Red River College and Assiniboine Community College). What conditions apply to me?

Students transferring from non-accredited universities or colleges may be eligible to receive credit if they can demonstrate that courses completed are of university standard and depth. Students must have satisfactorily completed a minimum of one year of study (30 credit hours or equivalent) with a cumulative grade point average of 2.50 (C+) or higher to be eligible for consideration. The general policy is that transfer credit will be granted according to the appropriateness of the courses for the degree program being sought and only for courses in which the student has received a grade of C or higher (except for the Faculty of Business and Economics which requires a minimum of a B). Students will receive a grade of S (Standing) for each course transferred. The specific grade earned does not transfer.
